

Once in your course go to the menu to the left and scroll down to find the Tutor.com Tool #1 and then just click on the Tutor.com tool link #2.










Step 1: Get started

When in your course go to the left menu to the Tutor.com menu item and then click on the Tutor.com link to access LEO.

Step 2: Get the right tutor

Step 3: Communicate


Use special tools
